CERTIFICATE OF COMPLIANCE

SUBJECT: HOYA (DBA SafeVision) Prescription Safety Eyewear

All Pentax branded frames have been tested to and meet the requirements of ANSI Z87.1 - 2020 for spectacle Rx eye protectors and are impact rated with Phoenix and Polycarbonate lenses. The lenses and frames are marked according to the Standard's requirements. The frames are marked Z87-2+ indicating impact rated, Rx-able spectacle, frames per the Standard. All Phoenix and polycarbonate lenses are marked with a "+" indicating impact rated, while glass and plastic lenses are not.

NOTICE: The ultimate level of protection for Safety Prescription Spectacles depends, not only on the frame, but on the prescription lenses and the frame as a complete protection system. The material, processing and insertion of the prescription lenses into a compliant frame can either complement or degrade the level of protection. Refer to the lens monogram to determine the suitability of Safety Prescription Spectacles for each specific workplace hazard. Only lenses marked "+" are impact rated by the ANSI Standard.

It is the responsibility of the factory owner or safety director to conduct a hazard assessment for the workplace and determine the appropriate eyewear protection required for each job. None of the frames offered by SafeVision provide Arc Flash protection.
